Urban trees and urban forests are the ultimate in green infrastructure. Trees provide beauty and cooling; they help attenuate storm water, which cuts down on erosion and water pollution and they increase property values and protect streams.

The Cuyahoga River Remedial Action Plan has initiated the Cuyahoga ReLeaf effort, the goal of which is to restore and enhance forest canopy within the county and the Cuyahoga River watershed. The first in a series of Forest Forums will be held in January in the Big Creek and Euclid Creek watersheds. The workshops will assist local governments, community leaders and watershed stewards in identifying areas where forest cover needs restoration, and in engaging support for restoration work.
