Want to Save Money and the
Environment?

**This Winter, Remember...
More Salt Doesn't Equal More Melting!**

Apply rock salt at the following rates
based on pavement temperature:

- 25-30° F => 1.5 lbs/1000 square feet
- 20-25° F => 2.25 lbs/1000 square feet
- 15-20° F => 3 lbs/1000 square feet

Never apply when temperatures are below 15° F.

Avoid applying salt to permeable pavers or pervious
concrete installations.

Don't plow snow into bioretention areas -
the weight compacts the soil medium,
reducing infiltration and effectiveness.
